<b>Chenin / Sauvignon Blanc, Highveld</b>	£17.25
2016 South Africa	
The nose leads with the Sauvignon aromatics, lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple from Chenin follows on the palate	
<b>Colombard, Baron d'Arignac</b>	£17.50
2014 France	
Floral with hints of pineapple and citrus. On the palate it's dry with lively balanced acidity and lemon	
<b>Pinot Grigio, La Delfina</b>	£17.95
2015 Italy	
Everybody loves a Pinot Grigio with its soft textures and nutty aromas	
<b>Chardonnay, Gran Hacienda</b>	£18.50
2016 Chile	
The aroma recalls tropical fruit, mingling with green apples, and rounded out by an alluring hint of zesty orange peel. A fresh ripe flavour with a round fruity mouthfeel, leads to a persistent aftertaste	
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Round Stone Bay</b>	£23.50
2016 New Zealand	
A really enjoyable Kiwi Sauvignon. Layers of crisp green fruit and sufficient refreshing acidity to work with spicy food	
<b>Petit Chablis, William Fevre</b>	£28.50
2014 France	
The bouquet of the Chardonnay is marked by great freshness. Both the bouquet and palate exhibit fruity, floral and mineral notes. A light and lively wine	

## ROSÉ WINES

<b>Pinotage Rosé, Highveld</b>	£17.25
2016 South Africa	
Radiant hues of pink with layers of strawberry and raspberry aromas. The wine is medium dry, crisp with a refreshing finish	
<b>Compass Point White Zinfandel</b>	£18.50
2014/15 USA	
Flavours of ripe strawberry and juicy watermelon combine with a delicate sweetness and freshness on the palate. Served chilled, it will partner well with lightly spiced fish, chicken, pork, herb salads or on its own
